## River Rises Anticipated Through the Weekend

## OVERVIEW:

Several rounds of rainfall along a slow moving cold front will bring river rises through the weekend, with the potential for some action or minor flood stages.

|  | - Light rain/drizzle will begin Wednesday with periods of rain, sometimes |
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TIMING heavy, anticipated through Saturday.

- Heaviest rainfall is anticipated to fall Thursday night through Saturday evening.
- Basin average rainfall forecast to range between $I .50$ to 2.60 inches over 72 hours.
- Latest ensemble guidance suggests a $30 \%$ chance of exceeding I8ft at Pittsburgh (see bottom graphic)
- Grays Landing forecast to 16.0 feet Saturay morning.
- Hannibal L/D forecast to 22.5 feet Sunday Afternoon.
- Exact placement of the axis of heaviest rain. Trend has been to track slightly farther south with each model run.
- Forecast Precipitation is slightly less.
