OVERVIEW:

- Showers and thunderstorms are likely by this evening.
- Scattered incidents of damaging wind gusts are the primary severe threat.
- Locally heavy rainfall is possible with repetitive storms.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The chance for thunderstorms with damaging wind gusts and hail will increase on Wednesday evening.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Damaging wind gusts are the primary, impactful threat. Large hail is possible as is an isolated tornado, especially over east central Ohio counties.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ There are no active alerts at this time.
FORECAST UNCERTAINTY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Forecast Confidence: Low. ▪ Severe threat may be inhibited as instability wanes during the evening.

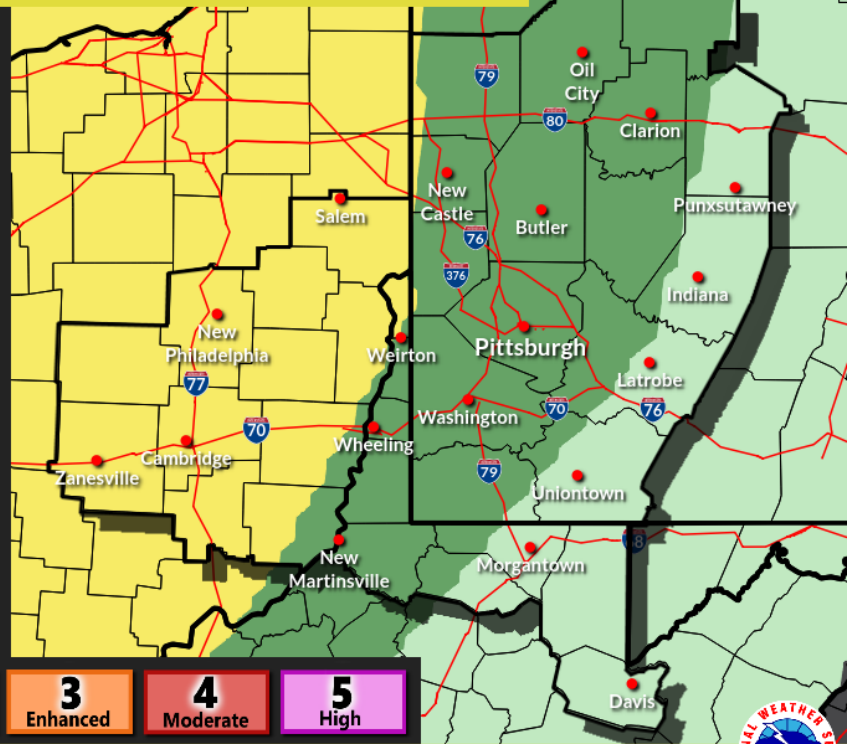
